Alliance to develop Uranium Deposits with Sinosteel Corporation Completed

Sinosteel Corporation (Sinosteel) and PepinNini Minerals Limited (PepinNini) have completed all formalities and finalised their Joint Venture Alliance to manage and operate the development of the Crocker Well and Mt Victoria Uranium Deposits and other commodities in the Curnamona Province of South Australia. A completion ceremony attended by representatives from both Companies as well as South Australian Government officials was held in Adelaide on 6th June, 2007.

At the ceremony Sinosteel presented a cheque for \$28.5 million (less payments of \$3.5 million already received) to PepinNini for a 60% stake in the Curnamona Province project. In addition Sinosteel will contribute A\$11 million exploration expenditure over the next 2 years for uranium and other commodities within the Project tenements.

The Joint Venture will be based in Adelaide where an office is currently being established and will undertake further exploration with the objective of preparing a Bankable Feasibility Study for the development of the Crocker Well Uranium Deposit. A Heritage Clearance Survey has been recently completed to facilitate the commencement of a proposed drilling program. It is the intention of the Joint Venture to get into production as soon as possible to take advantage of the current uranium market.

Norman Kennedy is the Managing Director of PepinNini Minerals Limited and has sufficient experience which is relevant to the style of mineralisation and type of deposit under consideration to qualify as a Competent Person as defined in the 2004 edition of the "Australasian Code for Reporting of Exploration Results, Mineral Resources and Ore Reserves".
