SALTA LITHIUM PROJECT - EXPLORATION UPDATE

The Directors of PepinNini Minerals Ltd(PNN, the Company) wish to announce that drilling permits have been approved and await signature next week by the Mining Secretary for drilling the Company's Pocitos Project. Community meetings are to take place today 27 April and drilling contractors will be confirmed next week with drilling to commence shortly thereafter. Phase 1 drilling will be two diamond core boreholes to test for Lithium brine bearing aquifers and sample collection to test for lithium grade. Sample results would be expected early June. Phase 2 drilling will be two pumping test wells to determine hydraulic properties of the aquifers.

Drilling permits have also been approved for the Company's Pular Project and drilling is planned there for the Spring.

Drilling Permit applications for the Company's Cauchari Project were lodged 20 April and granted permits are expected before July.




Figure 1 - PepinNini Salta Project Locations - Argentina.
